ENCROACHMENT PERMIT APPLICATION

January, 2000

The attached application form is to be used for all persons seeking permission to construct or modify facilities within the authority of the Tri-Dam Project.

The Tri-Dam Project, a joint management agency of the Oakdale Irrigation District and the South San Joaquin Irrigation District, operates Tulloch Reservoir under the provisions of a permit issued by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC). The permit as issued by FERC requires that the Tri-Dam Project review and approve all requests for excavation, construction, or placement of any facilities within the project boundaries. The limits of the project boundary extend to the 515' elevation, thus all facilities at the 515' elevation and below are subject to the encroachment permit process. Authorization from the Tri-Dam Project is required prior to the initiation of excavation or construction.

All applications are reviewed for compliance with applicable FERC license requirements. In addition to obtaining approval of the Tri-Dam Project, the application may require permits from other local, State and Federal Agencies, depending upon the nature and scope of the project. If additional permits are needed, the Tri-Dam Project will assist with this process. If the proposed project is commercial in nature, it will also require prior authorization from FERC, subject to license requirements.

APPLICATION CONTENTS

All applications must include the following information (as a minimum) to start the review process:

- a). Completed Tri-Dam Project Application Form
- b). Description of the proposed project.
- c). Intended users.
- d). Engineered site plan depicting the location of all facilities with elevations shown. Note that the 515' and 510' elevations must be clearly shown.
- e). Location of project within the reservoir and in relation to adjacent properties. The property dimensions and all property lines must be clearly depicted.
- f). Application fee. ~~\$500.00~~
